

### **── Why FileCare® EDTA?**

- removes smear layer
- of endodontic medication and filling material, as dentinal tubules are opened
- helps prevent files from blocking,
- reduces instrument fracture reduces friction on the instrument, because FileCare® EDTA works as a lubricant and pre-softens dentin

- easier penetration of the instrument,
- as FileCare® EDTA decalcifies dentin by binding the calcium in an electro-negative complex, thus overcoming blockages within the root canal.
